Guidelines for Poster Presentations

As referenced in the abstract submission form, posters should be 48" wide x 36" high.

Posters will be placed on wall-mounted bulletin boards or easels. Push pins will be provided.

There will be two poster sessions, each lasting one hour:

Session B (11:40 am – 12:40 pm)

Posters can be put up any time between 7:45 and 11:40 am, and need to be taken down at the end of the session at 12:40 pm.

Session D (3:40 – 4:40 pm)

Posters can be put up any time between 12:40 and 3:40 pm, and need to be taken down at the end of the session at 4:40 pm.

Both sessions will be held in the Center for Natural Sciences (CNS) Building on the first and third floors. The ID number for each poster appears in the abstract section of the conference program. Each poster location will have two ID numbers, one for the morning session (B) and one for the afternoon session (D).

Student presenters are expected to stand by their posters throughout the poster session.

Guidelines for Platform Presentations

As referenced in the abstract submission form, platform presentations should be no longer than 12-14 minutes, which will be followed by 3-5 minutes for questions.

Presenters should bring their power point presentation on a flash drive, and should arrive in the presentation room at least 15 minutes before the session starts so they can download their presentation onto the presentation computer and do a technology check.

A moderator will introduce each presentation, giving the title and names of the presenters. The moderator will also serve as timekeeper, giving warnings at 5 minutes left, 3 minutes left, 1 minute left and a firm stop at the 14-minute mark.

Between presentations, there may be some shifting of the audience from room to room, but during the presentations no one will be allowed to enter or leave so as to not distract the presenters.
